APPEAL OF TEXAS SERVICE CENTER DECISION

PETITION: FORM I-140, IMMIGRANT PETITION FOR ALIEN WORKER

The Petitioner seeks to employ the Beneficiary as its president and chief executive officer under the immigrant classification of a multinational executive or manager. *See* Immigration and Nationality Act (the Act) § 203(b)(1)(C), 8 U.S.C. § 1153(b)(1)(C). The Director, Texas Service Center, approved the petition but later revoked the approval. The matter is now before us on appeal.

On August 31, 2015, the Petitioner requested that the appeal be withdrawn. The appeal will be dismissed based on its withdrawal by the Petitioner. The withdrawal may not be retracted. 8 C.F.R. § 103.2(b)(6).

**ORDER:** The appeal is dismissed.
