



DISCUSSION: The Director, Nebraska Service Center, denied the immigrant visa petition. The petitioner appealed and the matter is now before the Administrative Appeals Office ("AAO"). On March 18, 2009, the AAO received a letter from counsel's office, which stated that the petitioner wanted to withdraw the I-140 petition. The AAO will accordingly withdraw the petition from any further processing. The withdrawal may not be retracted. *See* 8 C.F.R. § 103.2(b)(6).
